

Dear Advisors,

I hope you are well and enjoyed the chagim. Fall Convention is in about 10 days! And we are looking forward to having you each of you on the Shabbaton.

You are receiving this email because you signed up to give a session on Friday night. All of the information you will need to prepare for the session is included here.

The first file attached here is called "Advisor Copy" and provides you with an outline of how the session is to be delivered. To be clear, I am totally fine with you applying your own creativity and knowledge with the only provision being that you keep to the goal of the session. The goal is written out on the top of the Advisor Copy.

The second document is called "Newspaper". They are mock ups of newspaper articles prepared by our office as triggers for the session, as you will see when you prepare. Your session group will have a copy of this newspaper to read from during the session.

The final document is the source sheet that the NCSYers will receive during the session.

So that you can prepare properly, I have placed a grade and school type next to your name. This will help you orient your material toward your group of NCSYer. [Slight chance that a couple of these might change once NCSYers finish signing up for the Shabbaton. If it changes for you, I'll let you know...]
