DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Have you ever used a fake name? Why? (Maybe at Starbucks?)
- Where does your name come from? Where you named for somebody?

Activities/Hooks

- Read...Set...Reveal
 - o You'll need a large bed sheet as a barrier between the two teams.
 - Split into two groups on either side of the sheet. Each team sends a single representative. Count to 3 and the bed sheet drops! The participants have to yell out the name of their opponent.
 - o First one to call out the right name wins and gets a new player on their team.
 - The game continues until every player is on one team.

A Little Explanation

- 1. The Key and Peele video is a fun way to start out the conversation about names and their value.
- 2. The article from Freakonomics is not so easily readable but the message is powerful, so prepare it well before and skim through with the teens.
- 3. To answer the questions about choosing names, source 2 would suggest destiny comes first and you fulfill it and we always try to choose good names but that doesn't mean a person cannot overcome his "destiny" the fact that there is Divine inspiration in the naming still does not take away a parent's ability to choose the name they like and therefore similarly, a person has inspiration on his destiny through his name, but he can choose how he lives.
- 4. A change in name is almost like a change in identity. As we will discuss soon, the identity of the Jewish people in Egypt was maintained through keeping their names.
- 5. The source about the types of names should help wrap this all together so you don't want to skip it: whatever you are called, it is your "name" i.e. your reputation that counts.
