A Little Explanation

- 1. The source from the P'nei Yehoshua looks intimidating but it has a beautiful message. We say 600,000 letters, but there are only half! It is up to us to fill in the rest of the letters.
- 2. For more on Daf Yomi there is an article describing R' Meir Shapiro and the unity of learning Talmud
- 3. The passuk in Joshua is the source for the mitzvah to study Torah every day.
- 4. Chavruta Building Relationships
 - Consider mentioning the Mishna in Avot 5:17 about a Machloket L'Shem Shamayim will last. Specifically, the disputes between the Houses of Hillel and Shammai last until today because they weren't arguing for themselves, but to understand the Torah. Their joint effort not only merited them to be quoted for centuries, but developed a close connection between the two schools of learning (see Yevamot 1:4 or 13b).
